Required Gear List

The Voyageur Section combines in camp instruction and trail instruction so participants need to be prepared for both. The following is a list of required items you must bring with you *in addition to* the items listed on the NCS registration information.

Gear:

- 🍏 Backpack with waterproof liner or bags (garbage bag to fit will work)
- 🍏 Small Daypack: For both classroom sessions and the field experience
- 🍏 Compass: Orienteering style with rectangular base plate
- 🍏 Eating utensils: Cup, plate, fork, spoon, etc.
- 🍏 Firestarter: Matches, etc.
- 🍏 Headlamp or small flashlight
- 🍏 Pocket knife
- 🍏 Sleeping bag in a waterproof stuff sack or garbage bag inside the stuff sack
- 🍏 Sleeping pad
- 🍏 Tent: (Tents can be supplied if none are available)
- 🍏 Water Bottle(s)

Clothing:

- 🍏 BSA (Shirt, Pants/Shorts, socks) Check with employing council
- 🍏 Comfortable clothing for NCS classroom sessions
- 🍏 Swimsuit
- 🍏 Water shoes for canoeing is a must have
- 🍏 Hiking boots-extra socks: **NO COTTON!**
- 🍏 Nylon pants, long/short, **NO Jeans**
- 🍏 Jacket
- 🍏 Rain Gear
- 🍏 Hat with brim to block the sun

Personal Items:

- 🍏 Notepad/pen
- 🍏 Hand sanitizer (small bottle of alcohol-based gel)
- 🍏 Sunblock
- 🍏 Sunglasses
- 🍏 Towel, soap, toothbrush & other personal toiletries
- 🍏 Bug repellent/Head net (head net-optional)
